- ★ Workshops for teachers

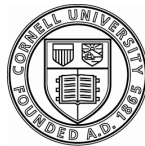
FACTS services are free and open to all parents and/or caregivers.

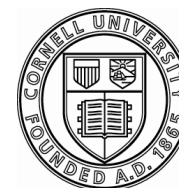
